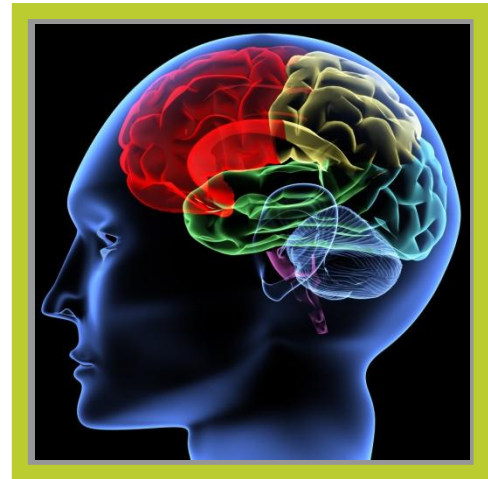

- Peripheral nervous system: all other neural elements, such as eyes, ears, skin, and other "sensory receptors"
